* Temporary footpath closure over Tasman Bridge from 21st August 2006

The Department of Infrastructure, Energy & Resources (DIER) is carrying out cable installation work on the Tasman Bridge from 21 August for up to two weeks. The upstream footpath will be closed to pedestrian and cyclists for the duration of the works.
